- Graduates employed in the field means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- Placement Rate Employed in the Field is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
