- Using your knowledge of lip application enhancements, locate two service guests with two different lip shapes to perform lip applications. Take before and after pictures.
- Break down the four quadrants of the lip and explain the shape worked on.
- Explain to the service guest the enhancement technique you have chosen and perform the technique.
- Show the service guest the difference using your before and after pictures.
- Take before and after pictures for documentation and add them to your personal portfolio.
- Give the service guest a business card to return for a future service.
- Share your completed activity with the Makeup Specialist.

- Use your knowledge of skin temperature and light and dark theory to customize a foundation application for a service guest. Take before and after pictures.
- Evaluate your service guest's temperature.

- Study the service guest's bone structure and discuss with him or her which areas he or she would like to enhance or minimize.
- Use your understanding of light and dark theory to contour and enhance the service guest's face.
